The Confederation of European Senior Expert Services a.i.s.b.l., CESES (www.ceses.net), is an European not-for-profit association incorporated under the Belgian law.

Created more than 10 years ago as the first legal entity of its kind, it is still the most important European-wide grouping of experienced senior volunteers.

It structures the cooperation of 19 organizations from 11 Member States and Switzerland.

Encompassing the skills and expertise of a life-time of over 25.000 senior experts with the greatest record of experience in all sectors of activity,

For each national Member Association and for CESES itself, efficiency is natural as the organizations are managed mostly by volunteers providing highly qualified work.

CESES network is not limited to Member Associations. It collaborates on a project-based basis with not-for-profit organizations with similar aims and with national, regional and local authorities.

What is CESES doing ?

The CESES Member Associations offer professional voluntary assistance to young workers, SMEs, not-for-profit organizations and public Institutions in Europe and abroad. Through our Member Associations, we have an extensive network of local representatives in many countries in the world.

CESES acts as the contract partner on behalf of its Members. Requests for assignments are assessed on their eligibility and then forwarded to the Members for the identification and matching of suitable experts.

Each expert is carefully selected, Member Associations implementing strict criteria concerning the quality, duration, diversity and complementarity of their operational experience.

Assignments are carried out within a framework of agreed-upon operational standards, including stringent quality and reporting requirements.

Dissemination of lessons learned and network to other organizations to foster and ensure knowledge is being incorporated in local context for further up-scaling and/or replication (long term sustainability).
